

ORDINANCE NO. 16-07-43

AMENDMENT TO SOLICITOR, PEDDLER AND CANVASSER REGISTRATION ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 93-05-14 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SOLICITOR,
PEDDLER AND CANVASSER REGISTRATION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mundelein, Lake County, Illinois, have determined that it is in the public interest to amend the solicitor, peddler, and canvasser registration ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: Section 2. Definitions. (B) of Ordinance 93-05-14 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

- B. "Peddler" means any person selling or attempting to sell any goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, or services of any kind and nature, being carried on or transported for immediate delivery or performance from house to house, building to building, or upon any street, highway or sidewalk within the Village of Mundelein.

Section 2: Section 2. Definitions. (G) of Ordinance 93-05-14 is hereby added with the following:

- G. "Foodstuffs" means meat, poultry, fish, seafood, vegetables, milk, dairy products (including pre-packaged ice cream products, popsicles, gelato etc.), and other food and beverages sold or offered for sale, whether fresh, frozen or sold in cans, bottles, boxes, cartons, or other containers.

Section 3: Section 3. A of Ordinance 93-05-14 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

- A. Except as provided herein, no solicitors, peddlers, or canvassers, as defined herein, shall be allowed to operate in the Village of Mundelein, or go upon any private residential property, without first obtaining a permit for the organization and a certificate of registration for each representative of the organization, and at least thirty days prior to engaging therein, shall submit to the Village Clerk a written application, under oath, for such permit and certificate of registration on a form furnished by the Village Clerk which shall contain the following information requested on the application:
 - 1. The applicant's name, present residence address, telephone number, social security number, and driver's license number.

2. The applicant's residence address during the past three years if other than present address.
3. The names, addresses, and telephone numbers of at least two references located in Illinois who can give accurate information as to the applicant's reputation for moral character, honesty, and integrity.
4. A brief description of the nature of the business in which applicant is engaged, and the kind of products or services to be sold or orders solicited.
5. Name, address and telephone number of the person, firm, corporation, or organization which the applicant is employed by or represents, and the length of time of such employment or representation; if less than three years, then the names, address and telephone numbers of each employer for the past three years.
6. If a motor vehicle is used, a description of same, together with proof of valid insurance and the current license number of such motor vehicle issued by the Secretary of State or such other identification as will serve to identify the vehicle and its owner. An identifying name should be included on passenger and drivers side of the vehicle.
7. Two photographs, size 1x1, taken within the past sixty (60) days, showing the head and shoulders of the applicant in a clear and distinguishing manner, together with a physical description of the applicant.
8. The period of time for which the certificate of registration is requested, which in no event shall be longer than one (1) year, or six (6) months for peddlers, the hours of the day that such function will be performed, and the approximate area within the village of Mundelein where the solicitation, peddling or canvassing will take place.
9. The date, or approximate date, of the latest previous application for permit and certificate of registration, if any, submitted to the Village Clerk.
10. A statement whether a permit and certificate of registration under this ordinance, or any similar ordinance of the Village of Mundelein, or any county or municipality, has been revoked, together with the details thereof.
11. Any additional information that the Village Clerk or Police Department may deem necessary to process the application, including but not limited to, detailed information of the ownership and management of the person, firm, corporation, or organization employing applicant or which applicant represents.

Section 4: Ordinance 93-9-32 is hereby repealed.

Section 6: All other ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby replaced.

Section 7: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 8: This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form according to law and available in the Village Clerk's office.

Section 9: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
