NARRATIVE

On the above date and time, Evidence Technician Thorgesen #116 (I/O) assisted Det. Schwab #124 at 5N663 Pearson Dr regarding attempting to locate evidence.

Upon arrival, Det. Schwab spoke with [REDACTED] at the residence. (See Det. Schwab's supplemental report)

[REDACTED] led Det. Schwab and I/O down to the area where his property runs along the Fox River. I/O was shown, by [REDACTED], approx where he was standing and where the dog was in relation to him when he discharged his firearm.

[REDACTED] showed I/O an area along a concrete boat launch/ramp where he advised he was standing. He then showed I/O an area approx 4-6 feet to the southeast where the dog was when [REDACTED] fired his pistol in the direction of the dog.

I/O then used a KCSO issued Nikon D7100 camera to photograph the area around the boat launch/ramp. I/O also used a metal detector in attempt to locate the projectile (bullet) in the ground in this area.

I/O observed the ground to consist of dirt and various size rocks. I/O used a small hand shovel in areas where the metal detector indicated possible metal objects. I/O did locate items such as a metal wire, fishing lure, beverage can tabs, etc. I/O was unable to locate a potential projectile or bullet in the ground in the area.

I/O does note that it had rained between the time of the shooting and the time when I/O was on scene. I/O was unable to visually locate any potential areas where the bullet may have entered the ground. I/O also notes that the area where [REDACTED] was standing is angled down towards the river and the dog was allegedly on higher ground when shot, which would affect the angle in which the bullet traveled and therefore the point of impact with the ground could vary.

I/O advised Det. Schwab that I/O was unable to locate the bullet in the area. The photographs will be uploaded to the KCSO case file.

I/O has nothing further.

NARRATIVE

I, Detective Schwab #125, spoke with two potential witnesses regarding the dogs. One witness (Witness 1) came forward, but wished to remain anonymous out of fear of retaliation. We deemed this person to be a credible witness and allowed them to be anonymous. The other witness, [REDACTED] was provided by [REDACTED] and he asked we contact her about the temperament of his dogs.

Witness 1 stated that they live in the neighborhood and know both the [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] but does not consider themselves close friends with either. They stated that [REDACTED] dogs have been seen out of the secured area of his yard approximately 10-12 times over the last year. On several occasions, they have seen both dogs coming across the [REDACTED] property approximately where [REDACTED] stated they crossed the property line. On another occasion, the dogs were aggressive towards members of Witness 1's family by barking, growling, and lunging at them. Witness 1 stated they have taken precautions, such as mounting pepper spray around the yard, in case the dogs become aggressive again and attack them. Witness 1 stated that the dogs are very obedient to [REDACTED] and immediately follow his commands, but do not seem to be as immediately obedient to [REDACTED]

I spoke to [REDACTED] via telephone, who explained she has lived next door to [REDACTED] for several years. She stated that [REDACTED] dogs have never been aggressive towards her, her kids, or her dog. She stated that the dogs are very friendly towards her and she has no concerns. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] dogs will often get out of his gate and come to her yard to play. When asked how often the dogs leave their yard and come to hers, she stated it was several times. [REDACTED] also stated that the dogs are very obedient to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated on one occasion, the dogs had gotten loose and she was walking them back to [REDACTED] house, when she saw [REDACTED] standing near the end of the driveway calling for the dogs. She acknowledged they did not appear to listen to [REDACTED] as well as they did to [REDACTED]

Elgin PD contacted me via email with the enhancement/enlargement of the video surveillance. Although they were not able to sharpen the image completely, they were able to make the video easier to see. After reviewing the footage, it appears that both dogs cross over the property line while [REDACTED] is very close to the river's edge. This happens almost immediately prior to the 911 call from [REDACTED] which would strengthen his version of events that they were on his boat launch prior to the shooting. At no point in the provided video does [REDACTED] appear to be chest deep in the water while holding [REDACTED] when he gets shot. All of the reports and videos were provided to the Kane County State's Attorney, who stated they would be reviewing the case and evidence to determine if any criminal charges were appropriate.

On 8/20/21, I spoke with [REDACTED] via telephone to inform him that I had turned over the case to the State's Attorney's Office. While on the phone, [REDACTED] suddenly exclaimed "Oh God! I have to

go...I have to go...Oh, God!". I could then hear [REDACTED] running and excitedly yelling "Philotimo! Philotimo!". [REDACTED] then abruptly hung up the phone. He called back a short time later and explained that [REDACTED] was chasing geese and he was afraid he would get out of his yard and get hurt. When I asked if [REDACTED] was in the yard, he stated he was but that it didn't mean he was safe.

NARRATIVE

On 8/13/21 I, Detective Schwab #125, interviewed [REDACTED] on his property. I informed [REDACTED] the interview would be audio/video recorded on my body worn camera. Det. Thorgesen # 116 assisted with potential evidence collection on his property. [REDACTED] signed a search waiver for the property, which was then uploaded to LERMS.

[REDACTED] began by explaining that he had been attacked by both of [REDACTED] dogs on 6/29/21. He stated both dogs had bitten him on the legs and groin area, causing injury to his knee. He stated he was transported via ambulance to the hospital where he received treatment. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was issued two citations for the incident, with a court date in DuPage County on 8/20/21. Wayne Police confirmed the incident via email and provided copies of the report and citations. [REDACTED] stated that because of that incident, he is afraid of the dogs and now carries his 5 shot Smith & Wesson revolver for protection.

[REDACTED] walked from his residence to the shoreline to show his actions and movements in the time before the shooting. [REDACTED] stated he drove his Gator down property to collect sticks and branches. I was able to observe the Gator, which still had branches and debris in the cargo area. [REDACTED] stated he was near the north property line of his property, close to the shoreline when he observed the dogs in the water. He stated he believed them to be about 4 feet from the water's edge. [REDACTED] stated he debated whether or not to stop doing his yard work because the dogs were outside, but ultimately decided to continue. [REDACTED] continued to pick up branches along the shoreline, parking his Gator near the picnic bench and then making his way by foot to his boat launch.

While on his boat launch, he turned around to find both dogs, Ludwig and Philo, on his launch between him and his property. [REDACTED] stated that the dogs were growling and baring their teeth, and beginning to circle towards him. He stated that one dog, later identified to be Ludwig, came within 5-10 feet from him where the south edge of the boat launch concrete meets the grass. [REDACTED] stated he was fearful of being attacked again and fired his revolver once at the dog. He heard the dog yelp and both dogs ran northeast onto his property, towards the fence boarding [REDACTED] property, and then turned directly towards the river. [REDACTED] stated he was able to see one dog, Philo, round the corner onto [REDACTED] property. The other dog, Ludwig, made it to the small rocky outcrop before falling into the river and floating belly up. [REDACTED] then called 911 to report the shooting and stayed on the line until law enforcement arrived. The walking distance from where [REDACTED] stated the shooting occurred to where he saw the dog fall into the water was approximately 300 feet. [REDACTED] retelling of the events to me was almost identical to his original version of the events to responding deputies. [REDACTED] claim of firing one round is corroborated after examination of the pistol, which showed one expended round and four live rounds in the cylinder. Det. Thorgesen #116 attempted to locate the discharged round with a metal detector in the general area that the shooting allegedly occurred. No round was recovered. See his supplemental for details.

I then went next door to speak to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who had several people at his house with him, including [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and his attorney, attorney's assistant, the installer of his security system, another friend, and an employee. All subjects were informed the interviews would be audio/video recorded on my body worn camera.

[REDACTED] and his team provided me with a written timeline of the events as they perceived them, based on the video surveillance from his rear camera. We briefly reviewed the video surveillance on [REDACTED] system, including a second video he wanted to show me which captured [REDACTED] driving on his Gator along the fence line at approximately 4:55pm, which would have been approximately 2 minutes after [REDACTED] left the residence with the dogs and right about the time she reached the gate. [REDACTED] alleged that [REDACTED] had been watching [REDACTED] saw her take the dogs to the river, and stalked and killed the dog. The video of [REDACTED] driving the Gator does not convey any premeditation on his part to kill the dog. I then walked with [REDACTED] and the attorney's assistant to recreate the events leading up to the shooting. Prior to speaking with [REDACTED] I spoke with [REDACTED] office manager [REDACTED] who stated she has a clear view of the river from her seat. I sat in her seat and was able to observe the area where [REDACTED] had stated the dogs were swimming. [REDACTED] stated she had seen [REDACTED] in the river with the dogs, but acknowledged she did not witness the shooting.

[REDACTED] stated that she walked down to the river and threw a stick for Philo. She pointed towards the north property line of [REDACTED] property and stated that Philo was there when Ludwig was shot. Initial review of the surveillance camera appears to show both dogs cross over the south property line. She then indicated that she and Ludwig were directly in front of the boat launch, approximately 15-17 feet from the river's edge. [REDACTED] stated she and Ludwig did not go near the property line because she knows [REDACTED] has pressed charges against [REDACTED] in the past. She then indicated that she was chest deep in the water with Ludwig, who then swam to her and they were hand in hand and basically "face to face" when she heard "boom, boom, boom". [REDACTED] stated the dog's hands dropped out of her hands, he went limp, and floated away towards the south property line and she grabbed him and dragged him towards the shore. This recounting of events contradicts [REDACTED] original statement that Ludwig was nearby and she didn't initially realize he had been shot. [REDACTED] had never previously mentioned she was holding the dog when it was shot. The initial review of the video surveillance appears to show [REDACTED] at the river's edge and not chest deep during the incident. [REDACTED] stated she was in the water for 8 minutes before the shooting. The video does not corroborate this version of events.

While we were back at the house, [REDACTED] again stated that there were 4 people at [REDACTED] residence watching them. Based on my observations, it would be almost impossible to see the rear of [REDACTED] residence from the back of [REDACTED] house. This would also indicate that [REDACTED]

could not see [REDACTED] leaving the residence from his house.

I then reviewed video surveillance with [REDACTED] and his associates. While watching, I commented that it was hard to determine exactly where [REDACTED] was and the dogs were during the interaction. [REDACTED] stated that he could see [REDACTED] holding Ludwig in the water, although I could not see that on the surveillance. I mentioned to [REDACTED] that it appears [REDACTED] is at the water's edge and both dogs cross the property line to the south, contradicting [REDACTED] version of events. It was also noticed that the video surveillance has several gaps or glitches where time is lost on the camera. The attorney's assistant acknowledges that [REDACTED] does not appear to be chest deep in the water at any time. On the video, [REDACTED] can be seen crossing over his south property line when he goes to the river to get Ludwig. [REDACTED] explained that he went around the corner to see what happened and observed [REDACTED] on his phone. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was on his boat launch and "smiling" at him. Based on the timestamp, [REDACTED] would have observed [REDACTED] on the boat launch approximately 1 minute after the 911 call is made. While listening to the 911 recording, [REDACTED] sounds slightly out of breath, but he does not sound like he is walking or running during the call, indicating he was on his boat launch the entire time.

Based on Google Map measurements, this would mean the distance between [REDACTED] boat launch and where [REDACTED] stated Ludwig was at the time of the shooting would be approximately 150 feet. Based on my training and experience with a similar firearm, and the opinions of several experience firearm instructors and operators, an accurate shot with that firearm at 150 feet would be highly unlikely, if not impossible.

[REDACTED] continued to attempt to enlarge the video in order to show the dogs were in the water when the shooting occurs. Because we were not able to agree on what was occurring, I informed [REDACTED] that we would be sending the video to another agency to attempt enhancement or enlargement.

[REDACTED] asked to go back down to the river to help recreate the incident and explain his side. While down there, [REDACTED] acknowledged that the dogs were possibly on or past the property line and [REDACTED] was calling to them. This contradicts [REDACTED] statements, but is corroborated by the video. [REDACTED] also stated that the veterinarian told him the dog was shot in the heart and killed instantly, meaning it would have died where it was shot. When I spoke with [REDACTED] from the St. Charles Vet Clinic, she stated she had never said that to [REDACTED]. She further explained that they did not perform a necropsy on the dog and could not confirm it was shot directly in the heart. She also explained that it would be possible for a dog to be shot in the heart and live a short time before bleeding out. I also spoke with [REDACTED] who is [REDACTED] personal veterinarian. [REDACTED] stated he had never examined the dog and did not tell [REDACTED] it was shot in the heart and died instantly, but rather [REDACTED] had told him that when he

spoke to him. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also agreed that a large dog could live for a short time, even if shot in the heart.

Prior to leaving, [REDACTED] and his associates expressed concern that Dep. Hernandez was seen at Wayne PD approximately 45 minutes after picking up the flash drive from [REDACTED] containing the video surveillance. They stated that they had concerns that the Sheriff's Office was somehow collaborating with the Wayne Police Department to compromise the investigation. I spoke with Dep. Hernandez, who stated he had responded to assist Wayne PD for calls for service at that time, which was confirmed by the dispatch tickets. He explained his presence inside the Wayne Police Department because he was invited there for a tour as the Kane County Sheriff's Office is now handling calls in Wayne during the midnight shift. Dep. Hernandez had sent out an email explaining the process for entering Wayne PD shortly after he was seen there, which would confirm his reasoning for being there. Dep. Hernandez stated he did not provide any evidence to Wayne PD and they did not ask for it. [REDACTED] had posted the videos in question to his social media page shortly after the alleged incident.

NARRATIVE

On 8/12/21 I, Detective Schwab #125, was assigned a case involving a dog that was shot and killed in Wayne, IL. Kane County Sheriff's Office assumed responsibility for the investigation after determining the person involved was the husband of the Wayne Village president.

I reviewed the case reports and supplementals from the deputies on scene, along with their body camera footage. I also reviewed the surveillance footage of the backyard of ██████ Pearson Road that was provided by ██████ ██████ While reviewing initial body camera footage, ██████ ██████ gave a statement to Dep. Schultz #171 and appears to be intoxicated during the initial contact with deputies.

██████ initially states to deputies that she had come down to the water with the dogs around 1:30 or 2:30pm and was swimming for 20-30 minutes before the dog was shot. It was determined through video surveillance that ██████ brought the dogs to the river at approximately 4:53pm and the dog was shot at approximately 4:58pm. ██████ also states that the dogs were a little past the property line and indicates by pointing the area in the river where ██████ property borders the ██████ property. A few minutes later, ██████ changes her story and states that neither she nor the dogs were anywhere near the ██████ property. ██████ then indicates that she and the dog were straight out from the boat launch, just past a watercraft docked in the water. Based on her description, it is believed she meant she and the dog were approximately 12-15 from the shoreline directly in front of the boat launch.

██████ stated one dog, Philo, was near their north property line in the water after chasing a stick she had thrown. She and Ludwig were in the water, with the dog swimming "inches" from her when she heard 4 shots. She stated she didn't notice right away that the dog was shot and never saw the neighbor shoot the dog. She then said the dog floated away south towards the property line. Based on the body camera footage, it appears the current was flowing north at that point. ██████ said she then retrieved the dog as it was floating towards the property line and dragged it towards shore, where ██████ ██████ then picked up the dog and carried it to the house. ██████ stated as she walked towards the house, she was able to see the neighbor (██████) sitting by his house with 3 other people. The property line on that side has heavy vegetation and trees, making it very difficult to see across the property line, let alone up to the house. This would contradict what was heard on the 911 recording where ██████ stated he was by himself outside and standing on his boat slip, which is where deputies observed him standing when they responded. in the water. He continued to pick up sticks and branches near the north property line and shoreline and made his way towards his boat launch, which is located approximately in the middle of his property. [REDACTED] stated he parked his Gator near the picnic bench, left it running, and went to the edge of the water on the boat launch to gather some large branches. When he turned around, he stated both dogs were on his boat launch between him and his property. [REDACTED] stated they were barking and baring their teeth in an aggressive manner. [REDACTED] stated both dogs began moving towards him, so he fired one shot from his snub-nosed revolver at the closest dog, which he estimated was within 10 feet. [REDACTED] stated to deputies that the dogs then ran through his property, towards the rocky embankment that borders the [REDACTED] property, where one dog continued and the other dog fell into the river and floated belly up. [REDACTED] stated he immediately called 911 and stayed on the boat launch until law enforcement arrived.

On 8/11/21, Dep. Hernandez #118 picked up a flash drive from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that contained video surveillance of the backyard. After reviewing the video, you can see [REDACTED] walking to the river with the two dogs. There are several times during the video where it skips ahead in time, indicating either the video was faulty or motion activated. The video appears to show [REDACTED] at the river's edge, but because of video quality it's hard to determine if she enters the water with the dogs. At one point in the video, it appears both dogs travel south past the property line along the river edge. The video then skips ahead approximately 20 seconds. When the video starts again, one dog is seen running up the yard and [REDACTED] is seen walking down towards the river. When he gets there, he appears to walk towards his south property line briefly, then reappears and carries the shot dog towards the house. Because the video quality makes it difficult to determine exactly where the dogs were at the approximate time of the shooting, I forwarded the video to Det. Oloris at Elgin Police Department. Det. Oloris stated they have a program that can often be used to enhance, clarify, or enlarge videos.







I Deputy Turcios #130 on Monday August 10th, 2021 at 1658 hours responded to ██████ Pearson Dr, Wayne for a shots fired complaint.

Once I arrived on scene I spoke to ██████ ██████ first, and then ██████ ██████ the owner of the residence. ██████ relayed the following in summary: ██████ advised that she was in the river swimming with the dogs when all of a sudden the neighbor, ██████ ██████ began to shoot at the dogs while she was swimming right next to them. ██████ heard four shots and stated she was within inches of the bullets. At that time, she grabbed the dog out of the river and their owner ██████ transported the dog to the St. Charles Veterinary Clinic where it was later deceased.

I then spoke to ██████ He relayed the following in summary; ██████ stated that he was inside of his residence. He had given permission to ██████ to take his dogs to the river which is attached to his backyard. After some time, ██████ heard approximately one to two gunshots followed by ██████ screaming. He ran to the end of the backyard to ██████ who was still holding the dog in the river. She advised that ██████ had shot the dog and almost shot her. That is when he transported the dog to the veterinary clinic.

In addition, ██████ stated on how neighbors on both sides of him have had disputes in the past and have treated his dogs poorly. ██████ was ticketed within the last month for dog at large because ██████ claimed that ██████ dogs attacked him while on ██████ property.

████████ submitted an audio statement on my Getac Body Camera System while on scene and was willing to sign complaints.

After speaking to ██████ I then retrieved the gun used in this incident from Officer Quarto #3119 from Wayne Police Department. The gun was ran through LEADS/SOS and came back as clear. In addition, ██████ did have a valid foic card.

Let it be known that the gun was a Smith and Wesson Revolver .38 caliber with a serial number of ██████ The gun had three live rounds and one spent casing. Evidence was placed into evidence locker 010.

Lastly, we looked around ██████ backyard and was unable to locate a bullet or any tracings of blood on the grass or near the water. There were not cameras on the property at this time. ██████ stated that he would be willing to do an audio recorded statement in the next few days when he calms down from the incident and has a clear mind.

Deputy Schultz and I then spoke with ██████ ██████ who informed us she was in the river with the dog when it was shot. ██████ provided a statement that was recorded on Deputy Schultz's body worn camera. The following statement is a summary of the body worn camera statement. ██████ stated she came down to the riverfront at approximately 1330/1430 HRS. ██████ stated she had two dogs with her, one named Philo and the other named Ludwig. Ludwig was the dog that was shot and killed by ██████ Ludwig and Philo are both white Doggo Argentino breeds. ██████ stated that one dog was swimming on the North side of the property in the water and the second dog was swimming towards the South side of the property in the river approximately ten to fifteen feet from the shore. She said she heard four gun shots but thought nothing of it because she did not believe they were directed at her or the dogs. Then she saw Ludwig floating in the water with his head submerged in the water. She noticed Ludwig floating South bound on the river so she grabbed him and brought him to shore. ██████ said she was inches away from Ludwig when he got shot. She mentioned she did not see ██████ shoot and did not see him by the river bank on his property. Also the river appeared to be flowing North which would have carried Ludwig North and not South like ██████ stated it did. Please see body worn camera statement for further.




NARRATIVE

On 8/10/2021, I, Deputy C. Kramer #150 was dispatched to 5N663 Pearson Drive to assist Wayne PD with a shots fired call. I was advised via dispatch that the caller, [REDACTED] had shot his neighbor's dog that had previously attacked him. [REDACTED] advised dispatch that the dog was in his property growling at him when he shot the dog and now his neighbor was screaming.

I arrived at [REDACTED] Pearson Drive where I met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was noticeably intoxicated and stated she had been swimming in the river with her two dogs approximately 10-20 feet from shore when she heard 3 popping sounds and saw her dog floating upside down in the river. [REDACTED] later stated she had heard 4 popping sounds and believed them to be gun shots but did not see any shots go into the water around her or see a shooter. [REDACTED] advised that where she had been swimming was behind 5N663 Pearson Drive approximately 10 feet offset from [REDACTED] Pearson if going by the property lines. [REDACTED] advised that the dog had been taken to the emergency veterinary clinic by the dog's owner, [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

I then went to [REDACTED] Pearson Drive where I met with [REDACTED] and Officer Quarto of Wayne PD. [REDACTED] advised that he had been collecting debris from his yard following the prior evening's storm when he had seen [REDACTED] swimming in the river with [REDACTED] two dogs. [REDACTED] stated that he continued collecting debris from the area and a short time later when he had picked up debris from his boat launch, the two dogs had gone into his yard and were now in between [REDACTED] and the rest of his property. [REDACTED] advised at this point he was stuck on his boat launch as the dogs were preventing him from accessing the rest of his property, with one dog approximately 10-15 feet away from him and the other 5-10 feet away from him, both growling and baring teeth. [REDACTED] stated that following the previous attack by the two dogs, he began carrying his 5-shot .38 special pistol with him on his property in case the dogs attacked him again. [REDACTED] advised that he was fearful of the two dogs on his property given the prior history and their aggressive demeanor. He stated he pulled out his revolver and shot the dog that was closest to him with one shot, and both dogs ran away. [REDACTED] stated the one he shot ran to the river's edge on his property before collapsing and falling in the river, then floating away belly-up. [REDACTED] stated the other dog ran to [REDACTED] where it resides. During this time, Officer Quarto had confiscated [REDACTED] pistol which was later turned over to Deputy Turcios #130 for evidence.



NARRATIVE

On 9/8/21 I, Detective Schwab #125, met with [REDACTED] on the walking path near the forest preserve at Rt. 31 and Red Gate Rd. [REDACTED] contacted the Sheriff's Office and stated he had witnessed the incident on 8/10/21 regarding the shooting of the dog. The interview was captured on my body worn camera, see video for full details.

[REDACTED] stated he was walking his dog along the path adjacent to the west side of the river when he heard a dog barking loudly. [REDACTED] stated that the barking was loud enough that he initially thought the dog was on the same side of the river as him. [REDACTED] described the barking as "alarmed or alerting", similar to when a dog barks at a stranger coming to the door. [REDACTED] dog then began looking across the river to where the barking was originating, which caused [REDACTED] to look in that direction. [REDACTED] pointed to the area of the incident, which was determined to be [REDACTED] property and [REDACTED] property on the east side of the river.

[REDACTED] stated that he heard the repeated barking, followed by a single shot and a dog yelping. He then saw the dog fall into the water from the upper ridge of the peninsula area just south of the property line. The dog fell into the water with its feet pointed up and then began drifting north with the current until a woman at the shoreline moved towards it and grabbed it. The woman, believed to be [REDACTED] began yelling for help and [REDACTED] saw a shirtless man, believed to be [REDACTED] come from the house and down to the river to retrieve the dog. [REDACTED] called 911, but was redirected to Kendall County Dispatch.

I asked [REDACTED] to break down in further detail locations and times for the events he witnessed. Below is a summary of his description, see the body camera footage for full interview:

[REDACTED] stated that while the barking was taking place he observed a woman, believed to be [REDACTED] standing on the river's edge approximately in the middle of the boat launch area on [REDACTED] property. During the conversation, [REDACTED] made it clear that it did not appear that [REDACTED] was ever chest deep in the water holding the dog. [REDACTED] stated that he believed her to be possibly calf deep at most. [REDACTED] stated that he could not see the dog while it was barking or when he heard the shot, but saw the dog "appear" on the peninsula area south of the property line just before falling into the water. I explained the layout of the properties and then asked [REDACTED] where the dog came from right before it fell in the water. He stated that it have appeared the dog came from behind the bushes on [REDACTED] side of the property line. This would be the same route [REDACTED] stated the dogs ran and the same spot and manner [REDACTED] stated the dog fell into the water.

[REDACTED] stated that while the barking was taking place, the man we determined to be [REDACTED] was standing approximately in the middle of his own property. Based on [REDACTED]

description, it appears [REDACTED] was standing on the grassy area of his property, away from the shoreline, near where he had told me he had parked his Gator. [REDACTED] stated he did not see [REDACTED] fire his gun and did not see the dog near him when he heard the shot, but stated he was not near the property line when that occurred. [REDACTED] stated he did not see [REDACTED] run from any area and was standing in the same area and appeared to be on the phone. This again is similar to the version of events [REDACTED] described to me during my initial interview with him, except [REDACTED] stated to me he was on his boat launch.

I asked [REDACTED] how long after he heard the dog yelp until he saw the dog fall into the water. [REDACTED] guessed it was approximately 2-3 seconds afterwards. I then asked [REDACTED] how long after he heard [REDACTED] yelling did [REDACTED] make it to the shoreline. [REDACTED] guessed it was 6-7 seconds. Based on the video surveillance, it took [REDACTED] approximately 45 seconds to reach the property line. I presented that information to [REDACTED] who then acknowledged that it would be very hard to determine the exact time, and stated that time seemed to be very different during the incident. [REDACTED] also stated he went back to the scene a few days later to take pictures of his view of the properties and circle where the dog fell in and where [REDACTED] was standing. [REDACTED] sent those images to me, which I then uploaded to LERMS.

I relayed the above information, along with the circle images, to the Kane County State's Attorney for consideration in their review of the case.
